# Vinegar as Cleaner

## Mix Equal Parts of Water & White Vinegar Solution

- Clean Carpets With Vinegar — (Red Wine Spills) Dab up excess with paper towels; Then spray with Water/Vinegar mixture & dab with clean towels and watch it disappear.
- Clean Your Shower head in a Snap — Soaking 30 minutes is all it takes. (And you hardly have to do anything.)
- Spray your kitchen & bathroom facets — Watch that white calcium build-up go. Repeat this every 2-3 weeks
- Makes a Natural Disinfectant — (That's Safer Than Bleach) You can use this on kitchen surfaces and produce. How 'bout that?
- Tackle Filthy Tile Floors — Hey this will get the grime out.
- Use it for a Streak-Free Window Cleaner — Works great on hard water spots
- Destroy Odors in Drains — Really, you should be doing this weekly or bi-weekly to keep your sink drain fresh and odor-free.
- Create a Bug Spray for Plants — Chemical-free way to buzz off bugs. Your beloved plants are going to be OK.
- Keep Your Iron Clean — Calcification build-up is no joke. Be sure to clean it once a month and you'll prolong the life of your iron.
- Makes Mold Disappear — Mold and mildew don't stand a chance in your shower. Spray this every 2 to 3 days.
- Clean Grease from Kitchen Cabinet Doors — Because the last thing you want; is your kitchen to be dirty. When you need to get aggressive with cleaning grease buildup, you'll want to include vinegar.
- Clean Oven Racks — Be prepared for how ridiculously easy this is.
- Remove Bakeware Stains — Why replace expensive bakeware when you simply restore it?
- Clean a Top Loading Washing Machine — Just because it washes clothes doesn't mean your machine is automatically clean. Do this every few months.
